

BCUA Computer and Electronics Recycling Center for Businesses

Moonachie, NJ: Most businesses are unaware that computer and electronic equipment contains toxic materials and heavy metals. These materials if thrown in the trash, will end up in a landfill or incinerated, potentially creating an unsafe environment.

To reduce the environmental impact caused by improper disposal, and at the same time increase recycling, Bergen County businesses can deliver used or unwanted computer and electronic equipment to the BCUA for a nominal recycling fee.

Recycling fees for 2007

\$0.14 per pound
for all acceptable equipment received

Payment Procedures

Payment is appreciated upon delivery of material. The BCUA has on-site a certified truck scale that will weigh your gross vehicle weight and your tare weight. The recycling fee will be determined by multiplying \$0.14 per pound to the net weight. Businesses are asked to bring a blank check at the time of delivery. The BCUA will be accepting checks only. Checks should be made out to the **Bergen County Utilities Authority-Solid Waste Division**. Cash and credit cards will not be accepted.

Each business will receive a recycling receipt indicating types and quantities of materials accepted at the recycling center.

Directions to the BCUA:

Route 17 North to the Wood-Ridge/
Moonachie Exit. Make a right onto Moonachie
Ave. and follow to the end to enter the BCUA
site.

Route 17 South to the Wood-Ridge/
Moonachie Exit. Make a left onto Moonachie
Ave. and follow to the end to enter the BCUA
site.
